Description of the role :

The Safety & Quality Manager leads the improvement and implementation of a genuine Safety and Quality culture across PLAKA. He drives the achievement of zero-accident work environment

- Supports the Management, Plant Managers and all other members of the hierarchical safety line as provided for in the KB of 27 March 1998 on Safety Policy; executes the tasks as provided for in the KB of 27 March 1998 on the internal service for prevention and protection at work. Ensure compliance with all regulatory bodies and standards
- Constantly evaluate, assess and alter safety procedures and policies for the benefit of employees and customers, in line with CRH procedures (16 Live Saving Rules). Implement CRH guidelines and processes across locations
- Perform safety audits in the various plants/warehouses, analyse accident reports and drive improvements.
- Ensure that all accident reports (including near-misses and safety observations) are recorded in a timely, complete, and accurate manner. And that safety and health hazards are corrected, eliminated or guarded
- Develop and implement training and other leading safety activities for workers and managers
- Instil a 'safety is MY responsibility' culture across all workers and managers
- Analyse all quality and non-conformity reports and drive process improvements. Liaise with sales, procurement and production to ensure an effective resolution for our customers
- Improve and promote the internal quality system in order to prevent non conformities and lead us to be the most reliable company in our market
- Responsible for the monthly reporting to CRH plc with regard to the established leading and lagging indicators (KPIs).
